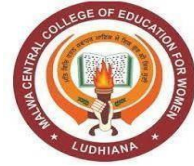

COMPOSITION OF ARYA BHATTA GUILD

Malwa Central College of Education for Women has established a number of Clubs and Societies with a aim of creating responsible citizens of the country. Arya Bhatta Guild is one of such efforts.

The Governing body of the Arya Bhatta Guild has team of eight office bearers consisting of Patron, President, Vice-President and Secretary and four office bearers i.e. Students as President, Vice President, Secretary and Joint Secretary. All student leaders are chosen on the basis of democratic principles i.e. on the basis of open voting. First of all the aspiring candidate nominates themselves or someone else proposes their names, followed by voting and candidates getting maximum votes are chosen as the office bearers.
